Careers advice: For those students who need guidance we are looking for employers to help form an independent panel will provide a 'Careers Triage'. Here we will utilize the skills of expert careers advisors, business HR managers education professionals and 'near peer' current students / apprentices to provide impartial 1:1 advice and guidance to mentor those students to reflect on possible options open to them.

Arrangements: exhibitors will have time prior to the event to set up their displays. The schools are then provided with a dedicated time slot at the event to ensure the learners have time to fully engage the exhibitors with whom they may wish to explore careers. From 16:30 'What Next' opens to the public for wider age ranges and provides the opportunity for parents / careers to attend and find out more.

Business Benefits: As well as supporting Corporate and Social Responsibility activities in the local community, there are numerous benefits from engaging with the learners and providers at the event;
